New Lectionaries – Advent 2024.

The Lectionary, which is the book that contains the Scripture readings for Mass and the Sacraments, is changing as part of the process of revising liturgical translations. This process began in 2011 and has continued with all the other liturgical text. The new lectionary will use the English Standard Version (Catholic Edition) of the Bible and the Abbey Psalter for the psalms. *Why are we making these changes?* These changes will make the translations we hear more faithful to the original text and to provide a more ‘proclaimable’ and more ‘inclusive’ reading. These changes will begin at the beginning of **Advent 2024**. Therefore, anyone using a daily Missal will need to consider buying a new edition. Changes will be made to the Mass sheets we currently use, and all scriptural text at Mass and other celebrations. If you have any queries or questions, I will be happy to help. **Fr Carl**
